Ludmila volunteers at St. Konstantin-Eleninsky in Kyiv - a monastery that has become a beacon of hope, providing sustenance to those who have lost so much in the war. Before Russia invaded, she volunteered occasionally. When the conflict began, she devoted herself full-time to serving those in need.

Today she is responsible for making 200-300 lunches each day for Internally Displaced People in her community. She takes great pride in her work and considers it a duty to both God and the people she serves.

Despite her efforts, it was a struggle to keep up with the demand for food. However, generous donors enabled Medical Ministry International to provide the financial assistance needed to keep Ludmila cooking and serving!


